Antik, which sold Scandinavian antiques in TriBeCa until May, has re-emerged in Greenwich Village as Hostler Burrows. When the shop opened in the late '90s, "people knew Hans Wegner, Georg Jensen, Jens Risom — three Danish designers," said Kim Hostler, an owner with Juliet Burrows. The women have since introduced other 20th-century Scandinavians.
