Best of Design Miami 2017

From Dec. 6–10, Design Miami returns as a main attraction in Miami Beach. Here, we've selected our favorite presentations.

Marking its 13th year, the annual Design Miami opens tomorrow, with 34 galleries hailing from New York, London, Paris, Milan, and beyond. This year's furniture, lighting, jewelry, and other objets d'art on view take a decidedly keen focus on craft. Our favorite is Patrick Parrish's strong, yet nicely coherent, mix of work by Bec Brittain, Clemens Kois, Julian Watts, and others. Guests are greeted with a big architectural moment, with Salon 94's presentation of Philippe Malouin's outsize poured concrete "Core" sculpture, which sits near an architectural model of the Bouroullec brothers' outdoor installation for the city's Design District. It's a powerful way to begin one's journey through the fair, which runs through Dec. 10.
