Ceramic Artist Kathy Erteman will be exhibiting 5 works in the 2019 Korean Ceramic Biennale September 27- November 24 in Icheon, South Korea.

44 artists were selected by an international jury from 1700 applicants to exhibit work and participate in the 9th annual Biennale commencing September 27.

Kathy will give a talk on her works in the exhibition and present a Monoprint and Clay workshop, in collaboration with a local Korean artist.
